## What is the Journey Adaptive Formation Program?

A Catholic based formation program begun in 2003 designed for people ages 6-adult with IDD, cognitive delays, and other special needs.

Lessons are taught in small groups using multiple sensory instruction to help learn and experience the faith. 6-8 students max per class
